### Dear Band Parents;

We would like to welcome you to **WEMEA** and the Santa Fe High School Band.

WEMEA is a 501©(3) non-profit organization primarily supported by Santa Fe Band parents. Funds raised by the organization go to directly support the band's activities. Our primary objective is to provide our students with the best possible band experience.

Throughout the course of the year, the **Santa Fe Band performs** at numerous marching and concert contests both in and out of the state of Oklahoma. In order for the band to participate in these events, **your financial support is necessary**. To **minimize fundraising activities** for that support, band parents are requested to contribute an activity fee of **\$230 per band student** payable to WEMEA (***\$150 each additional student if you have more than one band student in a family***) to meet the costs. Just a few of the many items covered by this student activity fee are:

- Marching shoes
- Polo shirts and SF caps for incoming freshman and new students
- Color Guard accessories
- Meals and refreshments at all marching competition (snacks, lunch, dinner)
- Band Camp lunches, snacks, drinks
- Transportation for band equipment and students to each contest
- Training camps or clinicians for Drum majors, Drum line and Colorguard
- End of Year awards and gifts
- Maintenance of SFHS Band's semi-trailer
- Most items required for certain performances and activities are also provided by this fee
- Flags, costumes and props for all band marching contest

### There are several methods to meet the Activity Fee contribution:

1. A check in the full amount paid during Band Camp (August 3rd thru 9th)
  - a. Full payments received by end of Band Camp will receive \$30 WEMEA merchandise voucher.
2. A check in the amount of \$120 paid during Band Camp with the balance due by September 30, 2010.
  - a. It is important to receive all the funds prior to the first Marching Contest.
